



Dr. Rousssel is a professor at the Cizik School of Nursing at UTHealth in the Department of Graduate Studies in Houston Texas. Prior to this role, she was a professor at University of Alabama at Birmingham, where she served as the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program director. She was a tenured professor at University of South Alabama College of Nursing where she managed the Executive Leadership and Clinical Nurse Leader tracks.
