



**Brief Biography for Professor Stephen Tee DClinP, MA, PGCEA, BA, DPSN, RMN, PFHEA, NTF**

Professor Tee joined Bournemouth University in September 2015 and is the Executive Dean for the Faculty of Health and Social Sciences. Before joining Bournemouth University, he was a Dean for Education at King's College London and Associate Dean at the University of Southampton. He has worked in health management and in higher education for thirty years and provided strategic and operational leadership in a range of senior roles.

He is currently leading on key aspects of Bournemouth University's new strategic plan (BU2025) focusing on developments in Medical Science, a new Institute of Medical Imaging and Visualisation and innovations in Digital Health.

Professor Tee's research interests include leadership, workforce and participatory approaches to health systems and health education. He has published widely on many aspects of health leadership, management and education and has edited books and journals. He was appointed Principal Fellow of Kings College London and the Higher Education Academy in 2014 and was awarded National Teaching Fellowship in 2015. He was a former Chair of the London Higher Healthcare Group in London. He has been assistant editor for Nurse Education Today for seven years.
